## **Executive summary**

At its April 2025 meeting, the OLC Board received an update on document production, associated governance, and the external audit status of the OLC's 2024/25 Annual Report and Accounts (ARA). The final version of the document reflects Board feedback provided at the meeting, which included considerations of demand complexity, value for money, and ED&I.

The external audit is nearing completion and has progressed well. Open communication between the auditors and the finance team has ensured timely responses throughout the audit. At the time of writing, all requested supporting schedules have been provided to the auditors and are currently undergoing review. There are no issues to flag at the moment, subject to final reviews. The ARA is now shared with the Board for final approval. ARAC's assurance of the final accounts is scheduled to take place in advance of this Board meeting.
